The 17th annual Orchard Lake Fine Art Show was held at Powers and Daly Roads from Saturday, July 27 to Sunday, July 28, 2019.

Hosted by Hot Works Fine Art and Fine Craft Shows, the art fair featured 150 professional artists selling original and handmade art, including paintings, sculpture, clay, glass, fiber, jewelry, photography, mixed media and wood.

When asked how he got into aqua reef art when based in Oklahoma, Steve Brewster said, "I have been a glass artist for 35 years and I make one of each piece... all sculptural pieces and I do what sells. Fish, animals, subject matter like that sells very well."

He said he's the opposite of a lithographer where if someone buys something from him, there's not going to be two of a kind.

Several professional people jury the show, according to Orchard Lakes Founder Patty Narozny. The show is juried based on originality, technique, execution and booth appearance," she said. "We make sure all of the artists make original art. It IS a major problem not only in Michigan but all over the country, nationwide."

She also said the show has been in the top 100 art shows in the nation 11 of the 17 years of its existence, including 2018.
